St Winefride's Day: This Sunday, 3rd November is the feast of St Winefride, patron of our parish. Month of Holy Souls: The month of November is a special time when we remember all our loved ones. New Encyclical: The fourth encyclical of Pope Francis, "DELEXIT NOS," translated as 'He loved us', centres on the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the boundless love Christ offers humanity. Released during the Synod on synodality, this encyclical emphasises the importance of turning back to what Pope describes as the 'heart' of both the Church and individual Christian lives. This document commemorates the 350th anniversary of the apparitions of the Sacred Heart to St Margaret Mary Alacoque, reminding us of this centuries-old tradition as a source of renewal and hope.
