From Bishop Mark Davies: This Sunday, Pope Francis will go to the Basilica of St Mary Major to pray the Rosary for peace at this troubled moment of humanity. The following day, Monday 7th October, the Feast of Our Lady of the Rosary, the Holy Father has invited those taking part in the Synod of Bishops to join him in a day of prayer and fasting, invoking the intercession of Our Lady for the gift of peace in the world. Let us be united with the Holy Father in this offering of prayer and penance for peace, especially on Sunday and on Monday.

Sacramental Preparation: Following last Sunday's enrolment Mass, the families embarking on the First Reconciliation and Holy Communion programme will now participate in their preparation sessions beginning next Sunday. We thank our parish catechetical team members who will help parents to prepare their children this year. We encourage the children to wear their sacramental badges when they come to Mass.

Little Church: Children's liturgy will take place during the Family Mass at 10.30. We encourage all children from the age of 4 and who are yet to receive the First Holy Communion to join children's liturgy.

Holy Rosary: October is traditionally the Month of the Holy Rosary. We encourage all those who can join for the Rosary in the month of October.
