World Mission Sunday, 20th October: On this day the whole church unties in prayer for its missionary activity and in collecting funds to support Catholic communities across the world. "Go and invite everyone to the banquet" is this year's theme chosen by Pope Francis. Bishop Mark reminds us that donations and prayer on this day have a direct impact on Catholic communities which are too small or poor to flourish without help from the rest of the church. Donations help faith communities and support vocations in often dangerous and remote places.
